## CHAMPAGNES AND FIZZ

<b>Prosecco Cielo DOC NV</b>	<b>37</b>
Light and refreshing, abounding with fruity notes of apples and citrus fruits.	
<b>Prosecco Cielo DOC NV Rosé</b>	<b>37</b>
Fruity and fragrant bouquet with hints of strawberry and cherry.	
<b>Crémant de Bourgogne, Caves de Lugny NV</b>	<b>55</b>
Made with 45% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir, 20% Gamay, the wine went through malolactic fermentation and was matured on its lees for 12 months. Aromas of citrus and apple with notes of biscuit. Generous and slightly creamy on the palate with a crisp finish and fine bubbles.	
<b>Jacques Bruère, Vintage Cap Classique, Brut Réserve, SA, 2014</b>	<b>55</b>
Handmade in the traditional 'Champagne' method with fruity, citrus notes, creaminess on the nose and a wonderful lingering finish. Named in honour of the Bruwer's French Huguenot lineage, from the Loire Valley.	
<b>Jacques Bruère, Vintage Cap Classique, Cuvée Rosé Brut, SA, 2013</b>	<b>55</b>
Jacques Bruère Cap Classique Cuvée Rosé Brut provides full rich yeasty flavours with hints of raspberry. Silky richness filled with red berries and balanced with subtle mineral undertones.	
<b>ROSL Champagne, Gardet Brut Tradition NV</b>	<b>70</b>
Based in Chigny-les-Roses in the heart of the Montagne de Reims, Gardet owns several hectares of Premier Cru vineyards. They produce great Champagne with 45% Pinot Noir, 45% Meunier and 10% Chardonnay. Fresh citrus fruit aromas with notes of honeysuckle a creamy texture on the palate with a refreshing acidity.	
<b>ROSL Champagne, Gardet Blanc de Blancs Prestige NV</b>	<b>110</b>
Composed of 100% Chardonnay from 1er and Grand Cru vineyards of the Côte des Blancs. Elegant aromas of lemon, peach and elderberry with notes of toast, almonds, hazelnuts and brioche. Delicate and vibrant.	
<b>ROSL Champagne, Gardet Brut Rosé NV</b>	<b>90</b>
Made of the same blend as Brut Tradition has fresh aromas of strawberries and raspberries, with notes of grapefruit and spice. Rich and fruity.	
<b>Champagne Laurent-Perrier, La Cuvée NV</b>	<b>110</b>
This wine comes from the purest grape juice and it alone allows Laurent-Perrier to craft 'La Cuvée', beautiful freshness obtained after a long ageing process in our cellars.	
<b>Champagne Laurent-Perrier, La Cuvée Rosé NV</b>	<b>150</b>
Perfected at each stage of its making, Cuvée Rosé is acknowledged for its consistency and its high quality. It is characterised by its ripe red fruit aromas, a high intensity and great freshness.	
<b>Bollinger, Special Cuvée NV</b>	<b>150</b>
Bollinger uses a high proportion of its own grapes for its blends, 85% of which are from Grand Cru or Premier Cru vineyards. Pinot Noir is cleverly teamed with Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier to produce their famous and opulent Champagne style. A classic full-bodied Champagne with wonderful balance, fresh fruit character and toasted brioche. Sourced from 30 different Crus this is the classic expression of Bollinger.

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## ROSÉ WINES

### FRANCE

**Été en Provence, France, 2022** 40

Classic Provence Rosé, nice mineral finish with delicate strawberry aromas.

**Roubine Rosé IGP Méditerranée, France, 2021** 45

Expressive aromas of red fruit, notes of currants with a lot of finesse and subtle flavors of wild strawberries.

### SOUTH AFRICA

**Post Tree Rosé, Swartland, SA, 2019** 27

Light colour, fruit driven and an easy drinking charm.

## WHITE WINES

### THE COMMONWEALTH

#### AUSTRALIA

**Bethany Riesling, Eden Valley, South Australia, 2016** 55

Located in Barossa, Bethany's vineyards are west facing and benefit from cooling breezes during spring and summer. This extends the ripening season allowing the grapes to achieve the right level of sugar and acidity. Notes of green apples, white peach, grapefruit and orange blossom.

**Sidewood Estate, Mappinga Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, South Australia, 2018** 55

Aromas of citrus, pear, ripe peach and honeydew melon on the nose. Following through onto the palate the flavours are enhanced with subtle hints of honey and nutmeg from the influence of 10 months maturation in French oak barrels.

**Hesketh Lost Weekend Chardonnay, Rhône Valley, Australia, 2022** 38

A lovely Australian chardonnay. Hesketh Lost Weekend is vibrant and youthful with an abundance of juicy fresh limes, stone fruits and a touch of toast. The palate is refreshingly smooth with zippy acidity and fresh fruits; limes, nectarines and lemon zest. Creamy on the finish, this is a definite one for lovers of white burgundy.

#### NEW ZEALAND

**Sauvignon Blanc, OTU, Marlborough, 2022** 40

This bold Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc presents aromas of passion fruit, lime zest and white nectarine. The palate is light-bodied, which builds and ends on a long, mineral finish with undertones of gooseberry, passion fruit and classic citrus fruits.

**Te Kano Life Series, Chardonnay, Central Otago, 2020** 60

The Lloyd family fell in love with this site located in Central Otago and decided to plant vineyards on it. They named the estate Te Kano, meaning seed in Maori. They produce a small selection from vineyards and barrels, which are often produced in extremely limited quantities. A refined and elegant Chardonnay with aromas of white peach, citrus and flint. Ripe peach, pineapple and nectarine flavours expand into complex biscuit and toasty oak, finishing crisp and dry.

#### SOUTH AFRICA

**Riesling, Grootte Post, Darling Hills, SA, 2022** 40

Ginger and spice abound on the palate with a long, lingering finish.

**Chenin Blanc, The Post Tree, Swartland, SA, 2022** 31

Crisp and refreshing with succulent tropical hints.

**Seasalter Sauvignon Blanc, Grootte Post, Darling Hills, SA, 2022** 45

Crisp and refreshing, succulent tropical hints, crisp acidity and a lasting finish.

### THE REST OF THE WORLD

#### A USTRIA

**Allram, Grüner Veltliner, Alte Reben, Kamptal, 2022** 48

A brilliant Grüner Veltliner, which impresses with its mightiness, power, and a long finish. Brilliant golden yellow, nuances of pineapple and apricots, warm and ripe, underlying hints of honey, spice, white pepper, full-bodied on the palate.

#### FRANCE

#### LANGUEDOC

**ROSL Club White, 2022** 30

Pineapple and ripe melon with a lime middle, soft easy drinking wine that has a crisp dry finish.

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REGIONAL VARIETALS

- Chardonnay, La Balade de Coline, Rhône, France, 2021** 33  
Elegant on the nose with citrus and exotic fruits. Slightly creamy on the palate yet very fresh and easy drinking.
- Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc, France, 2022** 37  
Pale gold colour, floral aromas with a crisp finish.
- Organic Ventoux Blanc, Château Unang, Rhône, France, 2019** 45  
Southern Rhône made from Clairette, Grenache Blanc, Roussanne grapes. Supple and vibrant, rich on the palate with a clean acidity on the finish.

ALSACE

- Jean Becker, Riesling Grand Cru, Froehn, 2017** 55  
The renowned Becker family, whose winemaking legacy dates back to 1610, produces wines of the highest standard and holds vineyards across five Grand Cru areas; Froehn, Schlossberg, Sonnenglanz, Praelatenberg and Schoenenberg. Located on steep slopes composed of clay and marl soils, Froehn benefits a south-east exposure producing wines that stands out for their fruitiness and weight. A superb Grand Cru with bags of minerality and soft aromatic notes. Full bodied on the palate with a good acidity and a very long finish.

BORDEAUX

- G de Château Guiraud Blanc, Bordeaux Sec, 2019** 50  
A classic Bordeaux Blanc with blend of Sauvignon Blanc (50% and Sémillon (50% with 80% aged for an average of seven months in oak barrels on the lees. A fresh fruit driven wine with aromas of peach and gooseberry, the palate is well balanced with a pure and elegant acidity.
- Caillou Blanc de Talbot, 2018-2019** 80  
With a majority of Sauvignon and a hint of Semillion, Cailloux Blanc is raised on its lees and stirred in a Burgundy manner. On the palate this wine expresses notes of apple, ripe lemon and small notes of quince associated with hints of crushed Mirabelle plums and fresh apricot.

BURGUNDY – CHABLIS

- Petit Chablis, Domaine Hamelin, France, 2021** 48  
Elegant palate packed full of fresh green fruits with a citrus finish, a great Chardonnay to have with fish or white meat or on its own.
- Chablis, Christophe Camu, 2021-2022** 60  
Christophe Camu, seventh generation, ferments all his wines at cool temperature using natural yeasts and produces pure, crisp and mineral whites. Fresh aromas of green apple, lemon peel and a wonderful saline minerality. Round on the palate and well-balanced with a crisp acidity. Perfect with seafood.

BURGUNDY – CÔTE CHALONNAISE

- Rully Blanc, Maison Jaffelin, France, 2021** 65  
Grapes harvested by hand, golden hue with green hints, very expressive on the nose. Wonderful Burgundian Chardonnay at its best.

BURGUNDY – CÔTE DE BEAUNE

- Bourgogne Aligoté, 'Les Pierres', Domaine Bader-Mimeur, 2019-2020** 60  
Golden yellow colour with bright reflections. Beautiful nose of white fruits, hints of fresh butter and vanilla. Round, seductive, fresh, and acidic evolution, great with oysters.
- Meursault, Domaine Michelot, 2018** 85  
This domaine achieved widespread recognition in the 60s under the direction of the charismatic Bernard Michelot. His spirit and tradition flourishes in the hands of the current generation. They focus on producing wine with a crystalline purity of fruit that display the finest characteristics of Meursault. Rich and delicate with honey, lime and hazelnut flavours. Beautifully balanced, this is nonetheless vibrant and snappy, ending with a mouth-watering finish.
- Puligny Montrachet, Jean Pascal et Fils, 2020** 90  
Jean Pascal's daughter-in-law Alexandra has been making the wine here for well over a decade, during which time she has overseen a steady and impressive upward trajectory in the quality and reputation of this small family Domaine. After spending 10 months on its lees in oak barrel (20% new, this Puligny is clean and intense, with a lovely buttery finish.



## BURGUNDY – MÂCONNAIS

### **Macon-Village, Domaine Chêne, 2021** 43

With vineyards in two top locations in the Mâconnais, La Roche-Vineuse and St Veran, this excellent Domaine has a huge amount to offer. Owners, Cedric and Nadine are dedicated supporters of the 'Lutte Raisonee' (minimum intervention system of agriculture). They keep yields low and pick late to help deliver a rich style, brimming with flavour and comparable to some of the wines produced in more illustrious areas of Burgundy. A wine that truly over delivers from a region where value is often hard to come by.

### **Pouilly Fuissé, Terroir Domaine, Seve, 2020** 60

Growing their grapes on slopes overlooking Solutre, one of the finest of all the Pouilly Fuissé villages, Sylvie and Jean Pierre Seve use oak carefully, not to create oaky flavours but to allow an exchange between oxygen and the developing wine. The results are spectacular. It was Pouilly Fuisse such as this that gained the commune worldwide acclaim originally. Aromas of white flowers and citrus fruits with hints of minerality. Buttery on the palate with a good acidity. This is a pure expression of Pouilly Fuissé.

## LOIRE VALLEY

### **Sancerre, Millet Roger, France, 2022** 50

The Domaine lies in Bué, one of the very best of the Sancerre villages, on limestone/clay soil which gives the typical mineral character of the region. A seriously stunning Sancerre. Great complexity with the classic minerality so traditional of Sancerre and all exhilaratingly fresh gooseberry flavours that you could ask for. Classic Sauvignon Blanc!

### **Menetou-Salon, Le Prieure Des Aublats, Henri Bourgeois, 2020** 60

A very fresh crisp wine from the Sauvignon Blanc grape. Floral and citrus aromas with good length, located a few miles from Sancerre.

## GERMANY

### **Pinot Gris, Villa Wolf, Pfalz, 2022** 40

The modern Pinot Gris is made in a full-bodied, dry style with fresh, unoaked fruit and a crisp texture. An excellent partner for salmon, chicken or pork.

### **Dr Loosen, Wehlener Sonnenuhr, Riesling, Kabinett, 2020-2021** 56

Displaying a lively minerality and a delicate crisp acidity that perfectly balances the bright flavours which are generally, apple, white peach and citrus.

## ITALY

### **Amori Pinot Grigio, Italy, 2022** 31

An intense bouquet of tropical and citrus fruits. On the palate it is medium-bodied and perfectly balanced, supple and refreshing. This is a versatile wine, pairing well with a great variety of dishes, or enjoyed on its own as an aperitif.

### **Gavi, Ca'Bianca, Italy, 2022** 38

Made from the Cortese grape, pale gold in colour with aromas of white flowers and ripe green fruit.

### **Grillo Parlante, Fondo Antico, Sicily, 2020** 48

From Sicily a bright lively wine with pale yellow reflections. A bouquet of floral fruits. Crisp and fresh with finesse showing a perfect balance between acidity and ripeness of fruit.

## SPAIN

### **Albarino, Vina Cartin, Spain, 2022** 48

Slightly creamy with refreshing pear and melon on the nose and lime peel on the palate.

## UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

### **The Federalist Chardonnay, Mendocino County, California, 2020** 55

The lees are stirred through malolactic fermentation, and the wine is aged (sur lies until blending). The Hungarian oak mimics French with spicy character and the American rounds it out with a sweeter finish.

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## RED WINES

### THE COMMONWEALTH

#### AUSTRALIA

**Hesketh Midday Somewhere Shiraz, Limestone Coast, Australia, 2019** 38

Medium bodied style, fruit flavours and spice with a natural acidity, ripe dark fruits.

**Vasse Felix, Cabernet Sauvignon, South West Australia, 2018** 80

A classic wine from a classic Margaret River producer. It delivers complex and intriguing dried sage, aniseed and violet aromas, which whisper through deeper notes of blackcurrant, dark chocolate and candied orange peel.

#### INDIA

**Grover Art Collection, Cabernet Shiraz, Nandi Hill, Karnataka, India, 2018** 48

Made by the renowned winemaker Michel Rolland from Bordeaux. Very deep garnet purple with intense notes of blackcurrant and blackberry. Concentrated ripe elegant dark berry fruit with great intensity and weight, complimented by soft tannins.

#### NEW ZEALAND

**OTU, Pinot Noir, Marlborough, NZ, 2021** 48

The wine displays dark cherry, black plum aromas with light cedar, smoky oak notes. A rich, concentrated palate follows, with fine tannins that will develop further over time

#### SOUTH AFRICA

**Post Tree Shiraz Cinsault, Swartland, SA, 2019** 31

Exciting blend of these two grape varieties, rich and rounded on the palate.

**OMB Red, Groote Post, Swartland, SA, 2021** 40

Fruit driven blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz, soft tannins and a smooth finish.

### THE REST OF THE WORLD

#### ARGENTINA

**Gouguenheim Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2021-2022** 38

Bright dark red colour with violet hints. Rich and full of scents of ripe fruits, plums, black cherry, black currant, chocolates, and violets. Well balanced acidity and a long finish. Good structure with soft tannins.

#### FRANCE

##### LANGUEDOC

**ROSL Club Red, 2022** 30

Blend of traditional and classic Mediterranean grapes and offers a fruity palate with soft, smooth tannins. A good introduction to French reds.

##### REGIONAL VARIETALS

**Carignan Vieilles Vignes Mécanique, France, 2022** 31

Juicy old vine Carignan packed with bramble fruit flavours and dark forest charm.

##### BEAUJOLAIS

**Beaujolais, Dom Cornilhac, France, 2021** 45

Deep ruby colour with purple highlights. Complex nose and an intense and persistent finish with a flavour of gamay grape.

##### BORDEAUX

**ROSL Club Claret, Château Argadens, France, 2018-2019** 42

Château Argadens has been owned since 2002 by the Sichel family, who are also part owners of Château Palmer and a number of other estates. Their aim is to make the wine a benchmark within the Bordeaux Supérieur appellation. Grapes are sourced from a parcel of 45 hectares located in Entre-Deux-Mers and the wine spends 12 months in oak barrels. The winery is named after the family which founded the estate in the 13th century.

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BORDEAUX – MARGAUX

**Château d'Angludet, Margaux, 2014** 96

In this ripe, classic wine, the tannins and black-currant fruit are equally important. Warm tannins are underlined by the fruitiness and richness of Cabernet Sauvignon, giving the wine a fine, medium-term finishing.

**Château du Tertre, 5ème Cru Classé, Margaux, 2016** 96

What a lovely expressive nose: the sweet red fruits combine with violet notes. The palate has structured, yet very fine, grainy tannins. The pure, crunchy red fruit flavours are immediately appealing. Château du Tertre always offers great value for money and the 2016 vintage is no exception.

BORDEAUX – PAUILLAC

**Château Pedesclaux, 5ème Cru Classe, Pauillac, 2017** 90

This is a juicy, fruity wine supported by dark fruit tannins. The blackcurrant fruits are bright and crisp, while the structure is firm and the lingering finish.

BORDEAUX – POMEROL

**Château Haut Chaigneau, Lalande de Pomerol, CB, 2015** 72

This 20-hectare vineyard is owned by the Chatonnet family. From this classic vintage, 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc oak aged. Deep purple with an intense bouquet of blueberry and blackcurrant. Aromatic and intense with notes of chocolate and plums. Soft tannins with very good structure, finesse and length.

**Château du Domaine de l'Eglise, 2010** 120

Deep, dark ruby-red color. Vivid, bursting black cherry and blackcurrant aromas, with leafy touches. Ripe black fruits on the palate are framed by clean cedary notes of spicy oak. The wine has fresh acidity and medium weight.

BORDEAUX – SAINT-EMILION

**Château la Dominique, Grand Cru, Saint-Emilion, 2015** 120

This rich, balanced wine comes from an estate that is performing in top gear. It is a generous wine, showing the luscious fruit of the vintage along with a good structure of dense tannins and layers of wood aging.

BORDEAUX – SAINT-ESTÈPHE

**Château La Tour de By, Medoc France, 2014** 55

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (60%, Merlot (35% and Petit Verdot (5% aged for 12 months in French oak barrels. Good dark, ruby red colour announcing a beautiful maturity of the grape, the nose has blueberry and blackberry aromas with hints of vanilla and oak.

BORDEAUX – SAINT-JULIEN

**Châteaux Langoa Barton, 3ème Cru Classé, Saint-Julien, 2011** 110

Deep, dark, opaque purple red colour. Lovely, lifted cassis and boysenberry aromas. On the palate the tannins are firm, drying and quite astringent. There is a lovely fresh cassis, boysenberry fruit and defined cedary oak. The acid is superb, giving the wine a long clean finish.

BURGUNDY - CÔTE DE BEAUNE

**AF Gros Morey, St Denis, 2016** 110

Sappy plums and raspberries on the nose. Retaining its violet florality, this has very pure raspberry fruit and seamless tannins, with just a hint of green spice on the back.

**Pommard Domaine, Joseph Voillot Village, 2016** 90

As good as the Volnay villages is Voillot's Pommard and may have the edge. A complex nose of wild berries, spice, bitter chocolate and rich soil tones precedes a supple, elegant finish.

**Volnay Domaine, Joseph Voillot Village, 2016** 90

Fruity on the pallet with a good length and discreet tannins. A great pinot noir that delivers!



## R HÔNE

**Organic Côtes du Rhône La Galatière Jean Loron, France, 2020** 45  
Medium-bodied with a sense of richness to the fruit, without over ripeness. Touch of liquorice. Well made, well balanced, with a ripe woody finish.

**Vacqueyras Château de Roques, Rhône Valley, France, 2019-2020** 45  
Eclipsed to some extent by the wines from its more illustrious neighbours, Gigondas and Châteauneuf, Vacqueyras offers exceptional value and deserves more recognition. Warm aromatic spicy fruit flavours with just a touch of lavender and thyme in the background and a gorgeous powerful finish. Delicious with a steak!

**Châteauneuf du Pape, Domaine de Fargueirol DB, 2020** 65  
The appellation is located on the left bank of the Rhône between Orange and Avignon on the Fargueirol plateau. Deep purple with a violet rim. An explosion of ripe fruit with hints of coffee and cocoa. Powerful concentration and very ample on the palate. Well balanced and good length.

## GERMANY

**ROSL Pinot Noir, Germany, 2020** 40  
Lightly aromatic red cherry fruit, a smooth, elegant fruitiness with a hint of spice and earthy complexity.

**Spatburgunder, Von Buhl, Germany, 2018** 45  
Silky, elegant Pinot Noir from this iconic German estate, light delicate and floral.

## ITALY

**Armigero Sangiovese di Romagna Riserva, Emilia di Romagna, Italy, 2018** 33  
Red berry aromas with notes of vanilla, liquorice and anise. Red and black cherry palate with some dried fruits.

**Fondo Antico, Nenè Nero d'Avola, Sicily, 2019** 48  
This elegant wine has hints of cherry and red fruits. Rich and concentrated with good length.

**Amarone della Valpolicella, Italy, 2018** 65  
An intensely flavoured red wine made from dried grapes and black olives. Cherry on the pallet, full-bodied with a long finish.

## PORTUGAL

**Churchills Estate, Douro Gra ite Red, 2019** 50  
Owned by Johnny Graham in the Douro Valley, made from the traditional Portuguese varietals Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca and Tinta Roriz. Deep violet colour with a spicy nose. Rich and concentrated with ripe berry flavours and hints of oak ageing with a long finish.

**Vina Albina Rioja Crianza, Spain, 2022** 40  
With spicy, roasted notes, the palate shows cherry and plum. Well integrated oak and a harmonious finish Classic Rioja!

## UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

**The Federalist Bourbon, Barrel-Aged Cabernet Sauvignon, 2017-2018** 75  
In the spirit of American craftsmanship, this unique Cabernet Sauvignon represents the bold, American tradition of aging in charred bourbon barrels. Sourced from Lodi in California, The Federalist Bourbon Barrel-Aged Cabernet Sauvignon intertwines bold fruit with rich, toasted vanilla and spice notes with a smoky caramel finish.
