Prosecco Cielo DOC NV		38
Light and refreshing, abounding with fruity notes of apples and citrus fruits.		
Prosecco Cielo DOC NV Rosé		38
Fruity and fragrant bouquet with hints of strawberry and cherry.		
Crémant de Bourgogne, Caves de Lugny NV		55
Made with 45% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir, 20% Gamay, using malolactic fermentation and matured for 12 months. Aromas of citrus, apple and biscuit notes. Generous and slightly creamy on the palate with a crisp finish and fine bubbles.		
Jacques Bruère, Vintage Cap Classique, Brut Réserve, SA, 2013		60
Handmade in the traditional 'Champagne' method with fruity, citrus notes, creaminess on the nose and a wonderful lingering finish. Named in honour of the Bruwer's French Huguenot lineage, from the Loire Valley.		
Jacques Bruère, Vintage Cap Classique, Cuvée Rosé Brut, SA, 2014		60
Jacques Bruère Cap Classique Cuvée Rosé Brut provides full rich yeasty flavours with hints of raspberry. Silky richness filled with red berries and balanced with subtle mineral undertones.		
ROSL Champagne, Gardet Brut Tradition NV		75
At the heart of Montagne de Reims, Gardet owns several hectares of Premier Cru vineyards. Made with 45% Pinot Noir, 45% Meunier, 10% Chardonnay. Fresh citrus aromas, notes of honeysuckle, a creamy texture and a refreshing acidity.		
ROSL Champagne, Gardet Brut Rosé NV		90
With the same blend as Brut Tradition, it is rich and fruity with strawberry and raspberry aromas, grapefruit and spice notes.		
Champagne de Venoge, Cordon Bleu Brut NV		100
Cordon Bleu is the purest reflection of the style and elegance of the Champagnes of the house De Venoge. Bright gold colour; wide aromatic complexity encompassing apples, lemon and honey.		
Bollinger, Special Cuvée NV		110
Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier are cleverly blended to produce this famous full-bodied Champagne. Wonderfully balanced with fresh fruit character and toasted brioche. Sourced from 30 different Crus this is the classic Bollinger.		
Bollinger, Special Cuvée Rosé NV		110
Luxurious notes of red berries, strawberries, red currants, lily and toasted wheat. On the palate, a subtle yet remarkable combination of structure, length and vivacity is given, with a tannic finish.		
ROSL Champagne, Gardet Blanc de Blancs Prestige NV		132
Composed of 100% Chardonnay from 1er and Grand Cru vineyards of the Côte des Blancs. Elegant aromas of lemon, peach and elderberry with notes of toast, almonds, hazelnuts and brioche. Delicate and vibrant.		
Bollinger, PN AYC18		150
Aromas of sweet vanilla tones, apple compote, orange blossom and pencil shavings. A precise palate, fleshy yet airy.		
Champagne de Venoge, Princes Rosé Brut NV		150
Strawberry and gooseberry flavours, paired with citrus aromas ensure this is a true wonder. The perfect aperitif or enjoyed with seafood.

- Bravio Cabernet Rosé, Chile, 2023** 32
Soft vanilla and strawberry notes

FRANCE

- Été en Provence, France, 2023** 45
Classic Provence Rosé, nice mineral finish with delicate strawberry aromas.
- AIX Coteaux D'Aix En Provence, France, 2022** 50
A fragrant and well balanced wine, salmon pink colour reveals a fruity freshness and premium rosé.

WHITE WINES

THE COMMONWEALTH

AUSTRALIA

- Bethany Riesling, Eden Valley, South Australia, 2016** 55
Located in Barossa, Bethany's vineyards are west facing and benefit from cooling breezes during spring and summer. This extends the ripening season allowing the grapes to achieve the right level of sugar and acidity. Notes of green apples, white peach, grapefruit and orange blossom.
- Sidewood Estate, Mappinga Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, South Australia, 2018** 55
Aromas of citrus, pear, ripe peach and honeydew melon on the nose. Following through onto the palate the flavours are enhanced with subtle hints of honey and nutmeg from the influence of 10 months maturation in French oak barrels.

NEW ZEALAND

- Sauvignon Blanc, OTU, Marlborough, 2022** 43
This bold Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc presents aromas of passion fruit, lime zest and white nectarine. The palate is light-bodied, which builds and ends on a long, mineral finish with undertones of gooseberry, passion fruit and classic citrus fruits.
- Te Kano Life Series, Chardonnay, Central Otago, 2020** 65
The Lloyd family fell in love with this site located in Central Otago and decided to plant vineyards on it. They named the estate Te Kano, meaning seed in Maori. They produce a small selection from vineyards and barrels, which are often produced in extremely limited quantities. A refined and elegant Chardonnay with aromas of white peach, citrus and flint. Ripe peach, pineapple and nectarine flavours expand into complex biscuit and toasty oak, finishing crisp and dry.

SOUTH AFRICA

- Riesling, Grootte Post, Darling Hills, SA, 2022** 43
Ginger and spice abound on the palate with a long, lingering finish.
- Chenin Blanc, The Post Tree, Swartland, SA, 2023** 33
Crisp and refreshing with succulent tropical hints.
- Seasalter Sauvignon Blanc, Grootte Post, Darling Hills, SA, 2023** 45
Crisp and refreshing, succulent tropical hints, crisp acidity and a lasting finish.

THE REST OF THE WORLD

AUSTRIA

- Allram, Grüner Veltliner, Alte Reben, Kamptal, 2021** 50
A brilliant Grüner Veltliner, which impresses with its mightiness, power, and a long finish. Brilliant golden yellow, nuances of pineapple and apricots, warm and ripe, underlying hints of honey, spice, white pepper, full-bodied on the palate.

FRANCE

REGIONAL VARIETALS

- Chardonnay, La Balade de Coline, Rhône, France, 2023** **34**
Elegant on the nose with citrus and exotic fruits. Slightly creamy on the palate yet very fresh and easy drinking.
- Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc, France, 2022** **40**
Pale gold colour; floral aromas with a crisp finish.
- Les Cépages Locaux, Viognier, Southern Rhône, France, 2020** **45**
Incomparable golden colour; extremely flattering, exuberant and gentle. It stands out with floral and yellow fruit notes. Delicate and smooth on the palate..

ALSACE

- Jean Becker, Riesling Grand Cru, Froehn, 2017** **60**
The renowned Becker family, whose winemaking legacy dates back to 1610, produces wines of the highest standard and holds vineyards across five Grand Cru areas; Froehn, Schlossberg, Sonnenglanz, Praelatenberg and Schoenenberg. Located on steep slopes composed of clay and marl soils, Froehn benefits a south-east exposure producing wines that stands out for their fruitiness and weight. A superb Grand Cru with bags of minerality and soft aromatic notes. Full bodied on the palate with a good acidity and a very long finish.

BORDEAUX

- G de Château Guiraud Blanc, Bordeaux Sec, 2019** **55**
A classic Bordeaux Blanc with blend of Sauvignon Blanc (50%) and Sémillon (50%) with 80% aged for an average of seven months in oak barrels on the lees. A fresh fruit driven wine with aromas of peach and gooseberry, the palate is well balanced with a pure and elegant acidity.
- Caillou Blanc de Talbot, 2019** **90**
With a majority of Sauvignon and a hint of Semillion, Cailloux Blanc is raised on its lees and stirred in a Burgundy manner. On the palate this wine expresses notes of apple, ripe lemon and small notes of quince associated with hints of crushed Mirabelle plums and fresh apricot.

BURGUNDY – CHABLIS

- Petit Chablis, Domaine Hamelin, France, 2021/2022** **55**
Elegant palate packed full of fresh green fruits with a citrus finish, a great Chardonnay to have with fish or white meat or on its own.
- Chablis, Christophe Camu, 2021/2022** **52**
Christophe Camu, seventh generation, ferments all his wines at cool temperature using natural yeasts and produces pure, crisp and mineral whites. Fresh aromas of green apple, lemon peel and a wonderful saline minerality. Round on the palate and well-balanced with a crisp acidity. Perfect with seafood.

BURGUNDY – CÔTE CHALONNAISE

- Rully Blanc, Maison Jaffelin, France, 2020/2021** **65**
Grapes harvested by hand, golden hue with green hints, very expressive on the nose. Wonderful Burgundian Chardonnay at its best.

BURGUNDY – CÔTE DE BEAUNE

- Puligny Montrachet, Jean Pascal et Fils, 2019** **96**
Jean Pascal's daughter-in-law Alexandra has been making the wine here for well over a decade, during which time she has overseen a steady and impressive upward trajectory in the quality and reputation of this small family Domaine. After spending 10 months on its lees in oak barrel (20% new), this Puligny is clean and intense, with a lovely buttery finish.

BURGUNDY – MÂCONNAIS

- Macon-Village, Domaine Chêne, 2021** **45**
With vineyards in two top locations in the Mâconnais, La Roche-Vineuse and St Veran, this excellent Domaine offer a huge amount. Owners, Cedric and Nadine are dedicated supporters of the 'Lutte Raisonnee' (minimum intervention) system of agriculture by keeping yields low and picking late to help deliver a rich style, brimming with flavour and comparable to some of the wines produced in more illustrious areas of Burgundy. This wine truly over delivers.
- Pouilly Fuissé, Terroir Domaine, Seve, 2020** **60**
Growing their grapes on slopes overlooking Solutre, one of the finest of all the Pouilly Fuissé villages, Sylvie and Jean Pierre Seve use oak carefully, not to create oaky flavours but to allow an exchange between oxygen and the developing wine. The results are spectacular: It was Pouilly Fuisse such as this that gained the commune worldwide acclaim originally. Aromas of white flowers and citrus fruits with hints of minerality. Buttery on the palate with a good acidity. This is a pure expression of Pouilly Fuissé.

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CÔTE-D'OR

Savigny-lès-Beaune 1er Cru Hauts Marconnets, Chanson, France, 2018 **65**

Pale gold colour with emerald tinges. Aromas of grapefruit mixed with fresh honey and almonds. Tense, precise with a tight texture.

Pernand-Vergelesses 1er Cru Les Caradeux, France, 2018 **75**

Very pure citrus mixed with apricot. Beautiful minerality and delicate oak note. Complex and well-structured. Beautiful minerality. Taut and fresh. Long and refreshing finish.

LANGUEDOC

ROSL Club White, France, 2023 **32**

Pineapple and ripe melon with a lime middle, soft easy drinking wine that has a crisp dry finish.

LOIRE VALLEY

Sancerre, Millet Roger, France, 2022 **55**

The Domaine lies in Bué, one of the very best of the Sancerre villages, on limestone/clay soil which gives the typical mineral character of the region. A seriously stunning Sancerre. Great complexity with the classic minerality so traditional of Sancerre and all exhilaratingly fresh gooseberry flavours that you could ask for. Classic Sauvignon Blanc!

Menetou-Salon, Le Prieure Des Aublats, Henri Bourgeois, 2020 **60**

A very fresh crisp wine from the Sauvignon Blanc grape. Floral and citrus aromas with good length, located a few miles from Sancerre.

GERMANY

Pinot Gris, Villa Wolf, Pfalz, 2022 **45**

The modern Pinot Gris is made in a full-bodied, dry style with fresh, unoaked fruit and a crisp texture. An excellent partner for salmon, chicken or pork.

Dr Loosen, Wehlener Sonnenuhr, Riesling, Kabinett, 2021 **60**

Displaying a lively minerality and a delicate crisp acidity that perfectly balances the bright flavours which are generally, apple, white peach and citrus.

ITALY

Amori Pinot Grigio, Italy, 2022 **33**

An intense bouquet of tropical and citrus fruits. On the palate it is medium-bodied and perfectly balanced, supple and refreshing. This is a versatile wine, pairing well with a great variety of dishes, or enjoyed on its own as an aperitif.

Gavi, Ca'Bianca, Italy, 2022 **40**

Made from the Cortese grape, pale gold in colour with aromas of white flowers and ripe green fruit.

SPAIN

Eguren Ugarte, Rioja Blanco, Spain, 2022 **40**

A bright white wine with scented, floral, citrus and delicate vegetal notes enveloping.

Albarino, Vina Cartin, Spain, 2022 **50**

Slightly creamy with refreshing pear and melon on the nose and lime peel on the palate.

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

The Federalist Chardonnay, Mendocino County, California, 2018 **65**

The lees are stirred through malolactic fermentation, and the wine is aged (sur lies) until blending. The Hungarian oak mimics French with spicy character and the American rounds it out with a sweeter finish.

Phelps Creek Chardonnay, Oregon, 2019 **75**

Aged in French oak barrels (10% new) for 11 months. Aromas of citrus, apple and white melon. Medium-bodied and round on the palate well-balanced with a bright acidity and a mineral finish.

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RED WINES

THE COMMONWEALTH

AUSTRALIA

Vasse Felix, Cabernet Sauvignon, South West Australia, 2018 90

A classic wine from a classic Margaret River producer. It delivers complex and intriguing dried sage, aniseed and violet aromas, which whisper through deeper notes of blackcurrant, dark chocolate and candied orange peel.

INDIA

Grover Art Collection, Cabernet Shiraz, Nandi Hill, Karnataka, India, 2018 50

Made by the renowned winemaker Michel Rolland from Bordeaux. Very deep garnet purple with intense notes of blackcurrant and blackberry. Concentrated ripe elegant dark berry fruit with great intensity and weight, complimented by soft tannins.

NEW ZEALAND

OTU, Pinot Noir, Marlborough, NZ, 2020 50

The wine displays dark cherry, black plum aromas with light cedar, smoky oak notes. A rich, concentrated palate follows, with fine tannins that will develop further over time

SOUTH AFRICA

Post Tree Shiraz Cinsault, Swartland, SA, 2019 33

Exciting blend of these two grape varieties, rich and rounded on the palate.

OMB Red, Groote Post, Swartland, SA, 2021 40

Fruit driven blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz, soft tannins and a smooth finish.

THE REST OF THE WORLD

ARGENTINA

Gouguenheim Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2022 32

Bright dark red colour with violet hints. Rich and full of scents of ripe fruits, plums, black cherry, black currant, chocolates, and violets. Well balanced acidity and a long finish. Good structure with soft tannins.

FRANCE

REGIONAL VARIETALS

Carignan Vieilles Vignes Mécanique, France, 2022 33

Juicy old vine Carignan packed with bramble fruit flavours and dark forest charm.

BEAUJOLAIS

Beaujolais, Dom Cornilhat, France, 2021 48

Deep ruby colour with purple highlights. Complex nose and an intense and persistent finish with a flavour of gamay grape.

BORDEAUX

ROSL Club Claret, Château Argadens, France, 2019 45

Château Argadens has been owned since 2002 by the Sichel family, who are also part owners of Château Palmer and a number of other estates. Their aim is to make the wine a benchmark within the Bordeaux Superieur appellation. Grapes are sourced from a parcel of 45 hectares located in Entre-Deux-Mers and the wine spends 12 months in oak barrels. The winery is named after the family which founded the estate in the 13th century.

BORDEAUX – MARGAUX

Château d'Angludet, Margaux, 2014 96

In this ripe, classic wine, the tannins and black-currant fruit are equally important. Warm tannins are underlined by the fruitiness and richness of Cabernet Sauvignon, giving the wine a fine, medium-term finishing.

Château du Tertre, 5ème Cru Classé, Margaux, 2016 96

What a lovely expressive nose: the sweet red fruits combine with violet notes. The palate has structured, yet very fine, grainy tannins. The pure, crunchy red fruit flavours are immediately appealing. Château du Tertre always offers great value for money and the 2016 vintage is no exception.

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BORDEAUX – PAUILLAC

Château Pedesclaux, 5ème Cru Classe, Pauillac, 2017 96

This is a juicy, fruity wine supported by dark fruit tannins. The blackcurrant fruits are bright and crisp, while the structure is firm and the lingering finish.

BORDEAUX – POMEROL

Château Haut Chaigneau, Lalande de Pomerol, CB, 2015 75

This 20-hectare vineyard is owned by the Chatonnet family. From this classic vintage, 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc oak aged. Deep purple with an intense bouquet of blueberry and blackcurrant. Aromatic and intense with notes of chocolate and plums. Soft tannins with very good structure, finesse and length.

Château du Domaine de l'Eglise, 2010 120

Deep, dark ruby-red color. Vivid, bursting black cherry and blackcurrant aromas, with leafy touches. Ripe black fruits on the palate are framed by clean cedary notes of spicy oak. The wine has fresh acidity and medium weight.

BORDEAUX – SAINT-EMILION

Château la Dominique, Grand Cru, Saint-Emilion, 2015 120

This rich, balanced wine comes from an estate that is performing in top gear. It is a generous wine, showing the luscious fruit of the vintage along with a good structure of dense tannins and layers of wood aging.

BORDEAUX – SAINT-ESTÈPHE

Château La Tour de By, Medoc France, 2014 65

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (60%), Merlot (35%) and Petit Verdot (5%) aged for 12 months in French oak barrels. Good dark, ruby red colour announcing a beautiful maturity of the grape, the nose has blueberry and blackberry aromas with hints of vanilla and oak.

BORDEAUX – SAINT-JULIEN

Châteaux Langoa Barton, 3ème Cru Classé, Saint-Julien, 2017/2018 110

Deep, dark, opaque purple red colour. Lovely, lifted cassis and boysenberry aromas. On the palate the tannins are firm, drying and quite astringent. There is a lovely fresh cassis, boysenberry fruit and defined cedary oak. The acid is superb, giving the wine a long clean finish.

BURGUNDY - CÔTE DE BEAUNE

AF Gros Morey, St Denis, 2016 120

Sappy plums and raspberries on the nose. Retaining its violet florality, this has very pure raspberry fruit and seamless tannins, with just a hint of green spice on the back.

Volnay Domaine, Joseph Voillot Village, 2016 96

Fruity on the pallet with a good length and discreet tannins. A great pinot noir that delivers!

CÔTE-D'OR

Pernand-Vergelesses 1er Cru Les Vergelesses, Chanson, France, 2017 90

An attractive red fruit nose of strawberries and dark raspberries. There is some tannin evident on the palate but its rounded and in balance.

Auxey-Duresses, Chanson, France, 2021/22 90

This wine has beautiful strong notes of leather, caramel and cherry fruit. On the palate its tastes red fruits of cherry, raspberry and strawberry.

LANGUEDOC

ROSL Club Red, France, 2022 32

Blend of traditional and classic Mediterranean grapes and offers a fruity palate with soft, smooth tannins. A good introduction to French reds.

RHÔNE

Organic Côtes du Rhône La Galatière Jean Loron, France, 2020 45

Medium-bodied with a sense of richness to the fruit, without over ripeness. Touch of liquorice. Well made, well balanced, with a ripe woody finish.

Les Cépages Locaux, Cairanne Caladoc, France, 2019 45

Recognisable for its aromas of very ripe red fruit and a slight spiciness. This wine offers the very best that Caladoc has to give

Vacqueyras Château de Roques, Rhône Valley, France, 2020 55

Eclipsed to some extent by the wines from its more illustrious neighbours, Gigondas and Châteauneuf, Vacqueyras offers exceptional value and deserves more recognition. Warm aromatic spicy fruit flavours with just a touch of lavender and thyme in the background and a gorgeous powerful finish. Delicious with a steak!

Châteauneuf du Pape, Domaine de Fargueirol DB, 2020 70

The appellation is located on the left bank of the Rhône between Orange and Avignon on the Fargueirol plateau. Deep purple with a violet rim. An explosion of ripe fruit with hints of coffee and cocoa. Powerful concentration and very ample on the palate. Well balanced and good length.

GERMANY

ROSL Pinot Noir, Germany, 2022 45

Lightly aromatic red cherry fruit, a smooth, elegant fruitiness with a hint of spice and earthy complexity.

Spatburgunder, Von Buhl, Germany, 2017 55

Silky, elegant Pinot Noir from this iconic German estate, light delicate and floral.

ITALY

Armigero Sangiovese di Romagna Riserva, Emilia di Romagna, Italy, 2019 34

Red berry aromas with notes of vanilla, liquorice and anise. Red and black cherry palate with some dried fruits.

Fondo Antico, Nenè Nero d'Avola, Sicily, 2019 48

This elegant wine has hints of cherry and red fruits. Rich and concentrated with good length.

Amarone della Valpolicella, Italy, 2019 70

An intensely flavoured red wine made from dried grapes and black olives. Cherry on the pallet, full-bodied with a long finish.

PORTUGAL

Churchills Estate, Douro Grafite Red, 2019 50

Owned by Johnny Graham in the Douro Valley, made from the traditional Portuguese varietals Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca and Tinta Roriz. Deep violet colour with a spicy nose. Rich and concentrated with ripe berry flavours and hints of oak ageing with a long finish.

SPAIN

Vina Albina Rioja Crianza, Spain, 2020 45

With spicy, roasted notes, the palate shows cherry and plum. Well integrated oak and a harmonious finish Classic Rioja!

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

The Federalist Bourbon, Barrel-Aged Cabernet Sauvignon, 2017/2018 75

In the spirit of American craftsmanship, this unique Cabernet Sauvignon represents the bold, American tradition of aging in charred bourbon barrels. Sourced from Lodi in California, The Federalist Bourbon Barrel-Aged Cabernet Sauvignon intertwines bold fruit with rich, toasted vanilla and spice notes with a smoky caramel finish.

Phelps Creek Pinot Noir, Columbia Gorge AVA, 2019 75

Rich nose of red berry, leather, earth and tobacco. Medium-bodied with a velvety texture and notes of spice on the palate, well-balanced with a polished acidity.

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
