Salveto Prosecco, Extra Dry, Italy, NV	39
Light and fragrant nose of white peach and acacia flowers, with a delicate, fruity and off-dry palate with fine bubbles.	
Prosecco Tiepolo Rosé, Extra Dry, Italy, NV	40
Fragrant nose of red fruits and minerals, with a floral and fruity palate with persistent bubbles.	
Crémant de Bourgogne, Caves de Lugny NV	55
Made with 45% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir, 20% Gamay, using malolactic fermentation and matured for 12 months. Aromas of citrus, apple and biscuit notes. Generous and slightly creamy on the palate with a crisp finish and fine bubbles.	
ROSL Champagne, Gardet Brut Tradition, France, NV	76.5
At the heart of Montagne de Reims, Gardet owns several hectares of Premier Cru vineyards. Made with 45% Pinot Noir, 45% Meunier, 10% Chardonnay. Fresh citrus aromas, notes of honeysuckle, a creamy texture and a refreshing acidity.	
ROSL Champagne, Gardet Brut Rosé, France, NV	100
Elegant and expressive, with a generous core of red berry and citrus notes. Fresh and lively on the palate, it finishes crisp and refined, making it equally suited to aperitif or light dishes.	
Champagne de Venoge, Cordon Bleu Brut NV	130
Cordon Bleu is the purest reflection of the style and elegance of the Champagnes of the house De Venoge. Bright gold colour, wide aromatic complexity encompassing apples, lemon and honey.	
Bollinger, Special Cuvée NV	120
Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier are cleverly blended to produce this famous full-bodied Champagne. Wonderfully balanced with fresh fruit character and toasted brioche. Sourced from 30 different Crus this is the classic Bollinger.	
Bollinger, Special Cuvée Rosé NV	150
Luxurious notes of red berries, strawberries, red currants, lily and toasted wheat. On the palate, a subtle yet remarkable combination of structure, length and vivacity is given, with a tannic finish.	
ROSL Champagne, Gardet Blanc de Blancs Prestige NV	150
Composed of 100% Chardonnay from 1er and Grand Cru vineyards of the Côte des Blancs. Elegant aromas of lemon, peach and elderberry with notes of toast, almonds, hazelnuts and brioche. Delicate and vibrant.	
Champagne de Venoge, Princes Rosé Brut NV	150
Strawberry and gooseberry flavours, paired with citrus aromas ensure this is a true wonder. The perfect aperitif or enjoyed with seafood.

Notes of green apples, white peach, grapefruit and orange blossom.	
Sidewood Estate, Mappinga Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, South Australia, 2023	60
Aromas of citrus, pear, ripe peach and honeydew melon on the nose. Following through onto the palate the flavours are enhanced with subtle hints of honey and nutmeg from the influence of 10 months maturation in French oak barrels.	
Adam Who? Riesling, Eden Valley, South Australia 2023	45
Aromatic nose of white peach and citrus blossom. Ripe pear and honeydew melon give way to a lingering, refreshing orchard fruit finish, with underlying slatey minerality. An expert balance between sweet fruit flavours and lemon/lime acidity.	
Parterre Semillon Sauvignon Fraser Gallop Estate 2022	60
Lime leaf and gooseberry on the nose, with just a hint of grassiness and nutty oak. An ultra-refreshing palate and punchy flavours of lemon-lime, with yellow grapefruit.	

NEW ZEALAND

Sauvignon Blanc, OTU, Marlborough, 2024	45
This bold Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc presents aromas of passion fruit, lime zest and white nectarine. The palate is light-bodied, which builds and ends on a long, mineral finish with undertones of gooseberry, passion fruit and classic citrus fruits.	
Te Kano Life Series, Chardonnay, Central Otago, 2022	65
A refined and elegant Chardonnay with aromas of white peach, citrus and flint. Ripe peach, pineapple and nectarine flavours expand into complex biscuit and toasty oak, finishing crisp and dry.

Ginger and spice abound on the palate with a long, lingering finish.

Wine packed with tropical and stone fruit flavours, with aromas of gooseberry and guava and a balanced acidity which delivers a fresh and fruity finish.

Crisp and refreshing, succulent tropical hints, crisp acidity and a lasting finish.

Allram, Grüner Veltliner, Alte Reben, Kamptal, 2023	60
Brilliant golden yellow, nuances of pineapple and apricots, warm and ripe, underlying hints of honey, spice, white pepper, full-bodied on the palate.	

FRANCE

REGIONAL VARIETALS

- Chardonnay, La Balade de Coline, Rhône, France, 2024** **38.5**
Elegant on the nose with citrus and exotic fruits. Slightly creamy on the palate yet very fresh and easy drinking.
- Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc, France, 2024** **44**
Pale gold colour; floral aromas with a crisp finish
- Les Cépages Locaux, Viognier, Southern Rhône, France, 2020** **45**
Incomparable golden colour; extremely flattening, exuberant and gentle. It stands out with floral and yellow fruit notes. Delicate and smooth on the palate..

ALSACE

- Jean Becker, Riesling Grand Cru, Froehn, 2018/2020** **65**
The renowned Becker family, whose winemaking legacy dates back to 1610, produces wines of the highest standard and holds vineyards across five Grand Cru areas; Froehn, Schlossberg, Sonnenglanz, Praelatenberg and Schoenenberg. Located on steep slopes composed of clay and marl soils, Froehn benefits a south-east exposure producing wines that stands out for their fruitiness and weight. A superb Grand Cru with bags of minerality and soft aromatic notes. Full bodied on the palate with a good acidity and a very long finish.

BORDEAUX

- Caillou Blanc de Talbot, 2020** **110**
With a majority of Sauvignon and a hint of Semillon, Cailloux Blanc is raised on its lees and stirred in a Burgundy manner. On the palate this wine expresses notes of apple, ripe lemon and small notes of quince associated with hints of crushed Mirabelle plums and fresh apricot.

BURGUNDY – CHABLIS

- Petit Chablis, Domaine Hamelin, France, 2023** **57**
Elegant palate packed full of fresh green fruits with a citrus finish, a great Chardonnay to have with fish or white meat or on its own.
- Chablis, Christophe Camu, 2024** **60**
Christophe Camu, seventh generation, ferments all his wines at cool temperature using natural yeasts and produces pure, crisp and mineral whites. Fresh aromas of green apple, lemon peel and a wonderful saline minerality. Round on the palate and well-balanced with a crisp acidity. Perfect with seafood.

BURGUNDY – CÔTE CHALONNAISE

- Rully Blanc, Maison Jaffelin, France, 2022** **66**
Grapes harvested by hand, golden hue with green hints, very expressive on the nose. Wonderful Burgundian Chardonnay at its best.

BURGUNDY – CÔTE DE BEAUNE

- Puligny Montrachet, Jean Pascal et Fils, 2021** **100**
Jean Pascal's daughter-in-law Alexandra has been making the wine here for well over a decade, during which time she has overseen a steady and impressive upward trajectory in the quality and reputation of this small family Domaine. After spending 10 months on its lees in oak barrel (20% new), this Puligny is clean and intense, with a lovely buttery finish.

BURGUNDY – MÂCONNAIS

- Macon-Village, Domaine Chêne, 2024** **50**
With vineyards in two top locations in the Mâconnais, La Roche-Vineuse and St Veran, this excellent Domaine offer a huge amount. Owners, Cedric and Nadine are dedicated supporters of the 'Lutte Raisonnée' (minimum intervention) system of agriculture by keeping yields low and picking late to help deliver a rich style, brimming with flavour and comparable to some of the wines produced in more illustrious areas of Burgundy.
- Macon Uchizy, Mallory et Benjamin Talmard, France, 2019** **55**
Lemon and white flowers abound on the nose. The palate is both refreshing and rounded showing minerals, hints of almond and peach.
- Pouilly Fuissé, Terroir Domaine, Seve, 2023** **65**
Aromas of white flowers and citrus fruits with hints of minerality. Buttery on the palate with a good acidity. This is a pure expression of Pouilly Fuissé.
- Saint-Veran Les Chatenays Domaine Carrette, France, 2023** **66**
The small appellation of Saint-Veran is one of southern Burgundy's insider secrets, offering supple, well-structured, subtly-fragranced chardonnays with a mineral accent. This wine comes from a small vineyard called 'Les Chatenays', a word from old French meaning chestnut grove. Owner and winemaker, Nathalie Carrette's goal is to make a classic chardonnay that is lightly creamy, fresh and mineral.

CÔTE - D'OR

Savigny-lès-Beaune 1er Cru Hauts Marconnets, Chanson, France, 2018 90

Pale gold colour with emerald tinges. Aromas of grapefruit mixed with fresh honey and almonds. Tense, precise with a tight texture.

Pernand-Vergelesses 1er Cru Les Caradeux, France, 2018 110

Very pure citrus mixed with apricot. Beautiful minerality and delicate oak note. Complex and well-structured. Beautiful minerality. Taut and fresh. Long and refreshing finish

LANGUEDOC

ROSL Club White, France, 2025 33.5

Pale lemon with green tints, with a grassy nose and a hint of tropical fruit. Quite broad in texture, with notes of apple, guava and capsicum, finishing fresh and dry.

LOIRE VALLEY

Sancerre, Millet Roger, France, 2024 65

The Domaine lies in Bué, one of the very best of the Sancerre villages, on limestone/clay soil which gives the typical mineral character of the region. A seriously stunning Sancerre. Great complexity with the classic minerality so traditional of Sancerre and all exhilaratingly fresh gooseberry flavours that you could ask for. Classic Sauvignon Blanc!

Menetou-Salon, Le Prieure Des Aublats, Henri Bourgeois, 2022 70

A very fresh crisp wine from the Sauvignon Blanc grape. Floral and citrus aromas with good length, located a few miles from Sancerre.

GERMANY

Pinot Gris, Villa Wolf, Pfalz, 2024 50

The modern Pinot Gris is made in a full-bodied, dry style with fresh, unoaked fruit and a crisp texture. An excellent partner for salmon, chicken or pork.

Dr Loosen, Wehlener Sonnenuhr, Riesling, Kabinett, 2022 60

Displaying a lively minerality and a delicate crisp acidity that perfectly balances the bright flavours which are generally, apple, white peach and citrus.

ITALY

Floralba Pinot Grigio, Venetie, Italy, 2024 36

A crisp and refreshing white wine from Sicily, showcasing a pale straw colour. It offers delicate aromas of melon, green apple, and citrus.

SPAIN

Bodegas Marques de Reinos, Rioja Blanco, Spain, 2024 40

Pale coloured with a nose of pears and citrus, backed by a hint of herbs and toast. The palate is medium bodied and crisp, with lively fresh fruits and a broad texture.

Albarino, Vina Cartin, Spain, 2024 56

Slightly creamy with refreshing pear and melon on the nose and lime peel on the palate.

PORTUGAL

Trajarinho Vinho Verde, Portugal, 2024 40

A bright lemon colour with notes of peach and apricot on the nose. There's a lovely pettience on the palate with lifted notes of lemon zest on the finish.

ROMANIA

Pasari Chardonnay Fetească Regală, Cramele Recaş, Romania, 2021 38.5

A blend of Romania's flagship white grape - the perfumed, silky Fetească Regală, with the rich stone fruit and yellow grapefruit of Chardonnay. Păsări honours one of Romania's great cultural traditions.

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

The Federalist Chardonnay, Mendocino County, California, 2018 65

The lees are stirred through malolactic fermentation, and the wine is aged (sur lies) until blending. The Hungarian oak mimics French with spicy character and the American rounds it out with a sweeter finish

Phelps Creek Chardonnay, Oregon, 2019 75

Aged in French oak barrels (10% new) for 11 months. Aromas of citrus, apple and white melon. Medium-bodied and round on the palate well-balanced with a bright acidity and a mineral finish

RED WINES

THE COMMONWEALTH

AUSTRALIA

Cabernet Merlot Fraser Gallop Estate, Western Australia, 2022 53

Redcurrant and cherry on the nose, with some dried herbs and a wisp of sweet smoke. Lively and refreshing on the palate. Bright berry fruit, dark plums and pepper, with supple tannins and a juicy finish.

Barossa Boy Little Tacker GSM, South Australia, 2020 55

Aromas of fresh raspberry, lavender and milk chocolate. The palate is generous and textured with ripe fruits of the forest, earthy notes of dark chocolate, toasty vanilla oak and a savoury finish.

SOUTH AFRICA

Hutton Ridge Shiraz, Swartland, South Africa, 2024 36

An array of juicy, ripe red berries with a touch of white pepper spice. Unoaked, light and easy-drinking with a smooth finish

OMB Red, Groote Post, Swartland, South Africa, 2024 48

Fruit driven blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz, soft tannins and a smooth finish.

La Brune 'The Valley' Pinot Noir, South Africa, 2025 60

THE REST OF THE WORLD

ARGENTINA

Gouguenheim Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2023 45

Bright dark red colour with violet hints. Rich and full of scents of ripe fruits, plums, black cherry, black currant, chocolates, and violets. Well balanced acidity and a long finish. Good structure with soft tannins.

FRANCE

REGIONAL VARIETALS

De Chansac, Carignan Vieilles Vignes, France, 2024 36

Deep coloured with rich brambly fruit, the palate is generous, spicy and soft, with flavours of black cherry and raspberry.

BEAUJOLAIS

Beaujolais-Villages, Manoir du Carra, France, 2023 50

From 70-100 old vines. Enticing nose of red fruits, some cherry and subtle spice, with a very Pinot Noir-like palate showing silky tannins, nice concentration of fruit and a subtle floral note.

BORDEAUX

ROSL Club Claret, Château Argadens, France, 2020 53

Château Argadens has been owned since 2002 by the Sichel family, who are also part owners of Château Palmer and a number of other estates. Their aim is to make the wine a benchmark within the Bordeaux Superieur appellation. Grapes are sourced from a parcel of 45 hectares located in Entre-Deux-Mers and the wine spends 12 months in oak barrels. The winery is named after the family which founded the estate in the 13th century.

BORDEAUX – MARGAUX

Château d'Angludet, Margaux, 2019 100

In this ripe, classic wine, the tannins and black-currant fruit are equally important. Warm tannins are underlined by the fruitiness and richness of Cabernet Sauvignon, giving the wine a medium-term finishing.

Château du Tertre, 5ème Cru Classé, Margaux, 2016/2017 96

What a lovely expressive nose: the sweet red fruits combine with violet notes. The palate has structured, yet very fine, grainy tannins. The pure, crunchy red fruit flavours are immediately appealing. Château du Tertre always offers great value for money and the 2016 vintage is no exception.

BORDEAUX – PAUILLAC

Château Pedesclaux, 5ème Cru Classe, Pauillac, 2017/2018 **100**

This is a juicy, fruity wine supported by dark fruit tannins. The blackcurrant fruits are bright and crisp, while the structure is firm and the lingering finish

BORDEAUX – POMEROL

Château Haut Chaigneau, Lalande de Pomerol, CB, 2016 **75**

This 20-hectare vineyard is owned by the Chatonnet family. From this classic vintage, 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc oak aged. Deep purple with an intense bouquet of blueberry and blackcurrant. Aromatic and intense with notes of chocolate and plums. Soft tannins with very good structure, finesse and length.

Château Bonalgue, Pomerol, 2018 **120**

Made with 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc, the wine is aged for 18 months in oak of which 50% is new. A very generous wine with intense and pure blackberry fruits and hints of tobacco. Velvety on the palate with silky tannins and good length.

BORDEAUX – SAINT-EMILION

Château la Dominique, Grand Cru, Saint-Emilion, 2016 **120**

This rich, balanced wine comes from an estate that is performing in top gear. It is a generous wine, showing the luscious fruit of the vintage along with a good structure of dense tannins and layers of wood aging.

BORDEAUX – SAINT-ESTÈPHE

Château La Tour de By, Medoc France, 2014/2018 **73**

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (60%), Merlot (35%) and Petit Verdot (5%) aged for 12 months in French oak barrels. Good dark, ruby red colour announcing a beautiful maturity of the grape, the nose has blueberry and blackberry aromas with hints of vanilla and oak.

BORDEAUX – SAINT-JULIEN

Châteaux Langoa Barton, 3ème Cru Classé, Saint-Julien, 2018 **110**

Deep, dark, opaque purple red colour. Lovely, lifted cassis and boysenberry aromas. On the palate the tannins are firm, drying and quite astringent. There is a lovely fresh cassis, boysenberry fruit and defined cedary oak. The acid is superb, giving the wine a long clean finish.

BURGUNDY - CÔTE DE BEAUNE

Volnay Domaine, Joseph Voillot Village, 2017 **110**

Fruity on the palate with a good length and discreet tannins.

CÔTE-D'OR

Pernand-Vergelesses 1er Cru Les Vergelesses, Chanson, France, 2017 **90**

An attractive red fruit nose of strawberries and dark raspberries. There is some tannin evident on the palate but it's rounded and in balance.

Auxey-Duresses, Chanson, France, 2021 **75**

This wine has beautiful strong notes of leather, caramel and cherry fruit. On the palate its tastes red fruits of cherry, raspberry and strawberry.

LANGUEDOC

ROSL Club Red, France, 2024 **33.5**

Medium-deep in colour with a lovely nose of black fruits and spices. The palate is medium-bodied, fruity and smooth, framed by ripe, gentle tannins.

RHÔNE

Chateau de Montfrin, Cotes du Rhone, France, 2024 47

Bright nose of black cherry, peony and cacao bean, with a fleshy and plump palate with lots of fruit and a touch of pink pepper.

Les Cépages Locaux, Cairanne Caladoc, France, 2020 45

Recognisable for its aromas of very ripe red fruit and a slight spiciness. This wine offers the very best that Caladoc has to give.

Vacqueyras Château de Roques, Rhône Valley, France, 2023 60

Eclipsed to some extent by the wines from its more illustrious neighbours, Gigondas and Châteauneuf, Vacqueyras offers exceptional value and deserves more recognition. Warm aromatic spicy fruit flavours with just a touch of lavender and thyme in the background and a gorgeous powerful finish. Delicious with a steak.

Châteauneuf du Pape, Domaine de Fargueirol DB, 2022 76

The appellation is located on the left bank of the Rhône between Orange and Avignon on the Fargueirol plateau. Deep purple with a violet rim. An explosion of ripe fruit with hints of coffee and cocoa. Powerful concentration and very ample on the palate. Well balanced and good length.

GERMANY

ROSL Pinot Noir, Germany, 2023 50

Lightly aromatic red cherry fruit, a smooth, elegant fruitiness with a hint of spice and earthy complexity.

Spatburgunder, Von Buhl, Germany, 2021 55

Silky, elegant Pinot Noir from this iconic German estate, light delicate and floral.

ITALY

Armigero Sangiovese di Romagna Riserva, Emilia di Romagna, Italy, 2021 38.5

Red berry aromas with notes of vanilla, liquorice and anise. Red and black cherry palate with some dried fruits.

Fondo Antico, Nenè Nero d'Avola, Sicily, 2019 50

This elegant wine has hints of cherry and red fruits. Rich and concentrated with good length.

Pinot Nero Tunella Italy, 2023 48

Smooth and spicy Pinot Nero from a family-owned estate in the far north-east of Italy. Crushed red berries on the nose, with a supple, juicy palate. Their Pinot Noir has juicy, crushed raspberry flavours, with delicate warm spice and shows off the characteristic 'Friulian' weight and elegance.

PORTUGAL

Churchills Estate, Douro Grafite Red, 2021 53

Owned by Johnny Graham in the Douro Valley, made from the traditional Portuguese varietals Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca and Tinta Roriz. Deep violet colour with a spicy nose. Rich and concentrated with ripe berry flavours and hints of oak ageing with a long finish.

SPAIN

Vina Amate, Rioja Reserva, Spain, 2020 45

Aged for 24 months in American oak. Classic Rioja, displaying a nose of blackberry, plum and red cherry with notes of toast and liquorice. Vibrant, Juicy with bright red fruit notes opening on the palate.

Gran Reserva Rioja, Fincas de Azabache, 2016 55

Silky and refined with red fruits, vanilla, coconut and well-integrated oak. Mature, smooth and balanced.

ROMANIA

Pasari Merlot Recas Cramele, Romania, 2023 40

Spiced plums and violets on the nose, with a soft and silky palate of juicy red cherries, raspberries, and toasty notes. Crafted at the esteemed Cramele Recas winery, this varietal Merlot holds a great reputation for its approachable complexity, ideal for both novices and wine enthusiasts seeking a comforting, rich-bodied experience.

Sanziana Pinot Noir Recas Cramele, Romania, 2024 40

A fresh, fruit-forward Pinot Noir showing vibrant notes of cherry, raspberry, and cranberry with a subtle hint of spice. Light-bodied and smooth, it has soft tannins, balanced acidity, and an easy, refreshing finish.

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

The Federalist Bourbon, Barrel-Aged Cabernet Sauvignon, 2017/2018 75

In the spirit of American craftsmanship, this unique Cabernet Sauvignon represents the bold, American tradition of aging in charred bourbon barrels. Sourced from Lodi in California, The Federalist Bourbon Barrel-Aged Cabernet Sauvignon intertwines bold fruit with rich, toasted vanilla and spice notes with a smoky caramel finish.

Phelps Creek Pinot Noir, Columbia Gorge AVA, 2019 85

Rich nose of red berry, leather, earth and tobacco. Medium-bodied with a velvety texture and notes of spice on the palate, well-balanced with a polished acidity.
